

A CLINICAL STUDY OF TRIPHALADI YOGA AS A VIRECHANA IN SHEETA-PITTA (URTICARIA) - A PILOT STUDY

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ABSTRACT

Sheetapitta (Urticaria) is one of the important and common skin problem described in Ayurveda.Mandal, Utsedha, Kandu(itching), Toda (pain), Chardi(vomiting), Jwara(fever) and Daha (burning sensation) are the symptoms of Sheetapitta(Urticaria) .PrakupitaVata and Kapha due to SheetaMarutadiNidana when being mixed with Pitta spreads internally and externally and resulted in to Sheetapitta (Urticaria). Panchakarma is the best remedy for better and permanent management of Sheetapitta (Urticaria). Virechan (Purgative) is one of the representative of *Panchakarma*. It is less stressful as compaired to *Vaman* (Emesis). Also the study on Virechana (Purgative) in Sheetapitta (Urticaria) is not fully emphasized. Hence, the study is aimed to check the efficacy of Virechana(Purgative) in Sheetapitta (Urticaria). Objectives are to study the reduction in symptoms of Sheetapitta (Urticaria) by Virechana (Purgative) using TriphaladiYoga. Materials used to be-Virechan Drugs (Triphala, Guggulu, Pippali) from Bhavaprakasha Nighantu..Methodology—This study includes a single group of 10 numbers of patients having symptoms of Sheetapitta (Urticaria). Observations-Data regarding age wise, Prakrutiwise, Koshthawise distribution of the patients, reduction in Symptoms of Sheetapitta, Observation of VirechanaVegas andObservation of side effects if any during procedure. Conclusion- VirechanaKarma by Yoga of Triphala, ShuddhaGuggulu and Pippali in Sheetapitta.is effective.

INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is a science which deals with healthy life by Shodhan (Purification) & Shaman (Internal medicines) therapy. Panchakarma, is the Shodhan (Purification) modality in Ayurved provides permanent cure in any type of disease(1). Vitiated Doshas (Impurities) are eliminated from the body and permanent relief from disease takes place. Sheetapitta (Urticaria) is a disease in which Dushti of Tridosha takes place(2). By means of Virechan (Purgation) all these impurities are removed from body. The drugs used for

Virechan having the properties like Tridoshahara, Samshodhana ,(Purification) Sara,(Laxative) Adhobhagadoshahara (Purgation).

Duetothesepropertiesvitiated *Doshas* are eliminated from the body and ultimately relieffrom symptoms of *Sheetapitta* (Urticaria) (3) Viz. *Mandal, Utsedha, Kandu* (itching), *Toda* (pain), *Chard* i(vomiting), *Jwara* (fever) and *Daha* (burning sensation) are reduced (4).

AIM AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. To study about clinical effects of *VirechanaKarma* on *Symptoms* of *Sheetapitta*.
- 2. To study in detail about Observation of *Virechan Vegas*, side effects if any by use of *Triphaladi Yoga*.

MATERIALS

INGREDIENTS OF *VIRECHANYO-GA:* For Decoction - Coarse powder of *Tri-phala ,Guggulu* and Coarse powder of *Pip-pali (5)*.

Properties of *Triphala*

METHODOLOGY

Case paper: A special case proforma was prepaired& the observations recorded there in.

10 number of patients were selected as per *Hetu, Samprapti, Lakshana* of *Sheetapitta*stated in *Yogaratnakar* and clinical trials conducted in BVMF'S Ayurved hospital, Pune-43.

Inclusion Criteria:-

- Patients with classical symptoms of SheetapittaVizMandala, Utsedha, Toda, Daha, Kandu, Chardi are included in our study.
- Patients of both Gender.
- Virechan Arha Patients.
- Patients above the age of 16 years and below the age of 60 years.

Exclusion Criteria:-

- Drug induced Urticaria.
- Patients having history of any chronic diseases.e.g. Heart Diseases, Paraplegia.
- Patients having symptoms of *Sheetapitta* but who is *Anarha* for *Virechan* were excluded
- Patients having the symptom of *Jwara* are excluded.
- Patients below the age of 16 years and above 60 years

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Subjective parameter are based on symptomatic relief, i.e. Mandala, Utsedha, Kandu, Toda, Chardi, Daha

Parameter of assessment:

Results were assessed as per scale shown below.

- I. Kandu, Daha& Toda severity was rated on a scale from 0 to 4 grades in which
- 4 = Very severe, warrants a visit to the physician.
- 3 = Severe, very annoying and troublesome, substantially interfering with sleep & daily Activities,
- 2 = moderate, annoying and troublesome, may interfere with normal daily activity and sleep.
- 1 = mild, not annoying or troublesome.
- 0 = indicates none
- II. Mandala score will be rated on a scale of 0 to 4 in which
- 4 = >15 mandala

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2 = 6 - 10 mandala

1 = 1-5 mandala

0= zero mandala

III. Utsedha score will be rated on a scale of

0 to 4 as per given below.

4 = more than 3 mm

IV. Chardi score will be rated on a scale of

0 to 4 as per given below.

4 = more than 3 vega / day

3 = 3 vega / day

DISCUSSION

Age: It was found that 36-45yrs age group is more prone to produce Sheetapitta followed by 26-35yrs of age group. There was no any patient was found in age gr. of 56-65 yrs.

Gender: Maximum no. of patients were female's than males. This indicated its more incidence rate is in females.

Occupation:It was found that housewifes were more affected by *Sheetapitta* followed by Servicemen. This indicated more incidences is in Housewife than others.

Prakruti: It was found that that maximum no. of patients were belonged to *VataKapha-ja*type of *Prakruti* followed by *Pitta Kapha-ja* and *KaphaPittaja*. This incidence showed that *Sheetapitta* is *Trdoshaj Vyadhi*.

Bala: It was found that Sara, Samhanana, Satmya, Abhyavarana Shakti, Jarana Shakti showed that maximum number of Patients are of Madhyama Samhanana, Madhyama Satmya, Madhyama Abhyvarana Shakti and Madhyama Jaran Shakti.

Koshtha: it was found that Maximum number of patients were having Madhyma

type of *Koshtha*, followed by were of *MruduKoshtha*. There were no any patient was found of *KruraKoshtha*.

Agni: Patients having Mandagni are found more followed by patients with Vishamagni. These both lead to Kaphaprakopa and Vataprakopa respectively, which are initiators of pathogenesis of Sheetapitta Vyadhi.

Virechana Vega: Maximum patients having 0-10 no of Virechan Vegas, followed by patients of 10-20 no of Virechan Vega. There were no any patient was having 20-30 no of Virechan Vegas. This indicates that there are less number of Virechan Vega produced by this Triphaladi Yoga Virechan.

VirechanShuddhi—

Almost all patients having *MadhyamShudd-hi*, followed by *HeenaShuddhi*. There were very few patients having *Virechan Uttam Shuddhi*.

CONCLUSION

This pilot study *Virechana* with *Triphaladi Yoga* shows statistically highly significant results in Symptoms of *SheetapittaVyadhi*-Viz-Mandala, *Utsedha*, *Kandu*, *Daha*, *Toda* and *Chardi*. Hence we can say that *Virechan* is Effective in *Sheetapitta Vyadhi*.

This study requires large number of sample size for further evaluation.

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
