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# MANAGEMENT OF YAUVAN PIDIKA (ACNE VULGARIS) BY VAMAN KARMA-A CASE STUDY

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### **ABSTRACT**

In this modern era, YauvanPidika (acne) is the burning problem in the adolescence. The modern measures regarding the treatment of acne are more or less failure. All these facts necessitate searching for a better remedy from the natural resources like herbs and minerals and other measures of Ayurveda. In YauvanPidika vitiated Vata and Kapha Dosha along with RaktaDhatu are involved. Vaman is the best treatment for eradication of vitiated Kapha. Here, a single case study of a 18 years old male patient is being presented who came with complaints of Comedones, Red Papules, pustules, Nodules Round chick, Forehead, Back and forearms, with Vedana. Daha. Kandu, Paka and Vaivarnyata. Considering the signs and symptoms of YauvanPidika, Vamankarma was selected. Marked improvement in signs and symptoms of YauvanPidika were found.

### INTRODUCTION

Nature has taught human various dimensions of beauty, with the gradual development of human mind, since the creation of the Universe. Beauty is that quality or combination of qualities which afford keen pleasure to the senses especially that of sight or which charms the intellectual of moral faculties. Face is the most important and beautiful organ. Face reflects the personality of person.

A great philosopher says that human faces express and represent their personality and wisdom. According to Ayurveda among the 56 *Upangas* face is at the top so everyone and mostly youngsters are most cautious and careful about the beauty of face.

YauvanPidika (Acne vulgaris) is one of the most common dermatosis, which develops at puberty and young age, which are the wonder

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years of an individual's life and when they are more conscious about the beauty. It leads to unattractive look and permanent disfigurement of the face, which may result in inferiority complex and sometimes isolation in the social life.

In YauvanPidika vitiation of Vata and Kapha Dosha along with RaktaDhatu is described. Acharya Sushruta mentioned 'YauvanPidika' under the heading of "KSHUDRA ROGA" and described 'VAMAN KARMA' as its treatment. The signs and symptoms of YauvanPidika can be correlated with 'Acne vulgaris' according to modern view. YauvanPidika, the disease name itself shows that the disease almost takes place in young age.

Modern science believes that it is due to infection of certain organism, but the disease is no more a simple reaction to bacterial infection. It occurs due to stress, influence of endocrine glands of the body, particularly the ovary & testis. Sometime it occurs in particular race, age, nutritional status, temperature, excessive use of cosmetics.

The modern measures regarding the treatment of acne are more or less failure. Although for prevention of the further infection, dislodging of the black heads and to moisturize the skin, various preparation are in practice like antibiotics, internal use of vitamin-A, hormones and cosmetic lotions for external application. Sometimes Ultraviolet Radiation therapies are also in practice. Corticosteroid has revolutionized the treatment but it's too much side ef-

fects and temporary relief has limited the therapy. All these facts necessitate searching for a better remedy from the natural resources like herbs and minerals and other measures of Ayurveda.

In YauvanPidika vitiated Vata and Kapha Dosha along with RaktaDhatu are involved. Vaman is the best treatment for eradication of vitiated Kapha. Rakta is Pitta Vargiya Dravya and Vamana purifies the Pitta also at some extent and thus it purifies the Rakta. In YauvanPidika, Srotorodha is also seen in SwedavahaSrotasa, Vamana drug with its Ushna, Tikshana, and Sookshma, Vyavyi, & Vikasi properties enters the large & small Srotas of the body and clears the Srotavarodha, which helps in breaking the chain of Samprapti.

Selection of *Vamana Karma* was based on repeated recommendations by different *Acharyas* in the management of *Yauvan-Pidika*. This disease is very stubborn in nature; perhaps this might be the reason that almost all the *Acharyas* have advocated such a difficult procedure for the management of the disease.

Dosha should be eliminated from the nearest path. YauvanPidika is UrdhvaJatrugataVyadhi and Vaman expels the Dosha from the Mukhamarga. Therefore Vaman Karma will give better results than any otherShodhana Karma. Considering all these factors it is decided to prove efficacy of Vaman Karma in the management of YauvanPidika

#### HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS

Patient was asymptomatic before 2 years. Then gradually he developed Comedones, Papules, Pustules and Nodules round forehead, Chicks, Back and Forearms. He felt Itching and also felt burning, Sebum Discharge, Discoloration at site. So for proper treatment he came here in our hospital.

**PAST HISTORY:** No relevant past history was found.

**TREATMENT HISTORY:** Patient had taken Allopathic treatment but did not get satisfactory result.

#### NIDANA FOUND IN THE PATIENT

### *AaharajNidana*

Excessive consumption of Amla. LavanKatu, Drava, Snigdha and GuruAhara, Pishtanna, Kshir and occasionally Viruddhaahara.

### Viharaj Nidana

Vyayam and Atisantapsevan after consumption of food, Diwaswap, irregular Shitaushnasevan,

**Addiction:** Addiction of Tea 3 years.

**Family History:** No relevant family history was found.

**Treatment Protocol:** 

**Karma** – *Vaman karma* was selected.

Vaman Karma

Shodhana: Vaman karma is divided into 3 parts.

(A) Purva Karma:

### 1) Deepana and Pachana

• Drug – *TrikatuChurna* 

• Dose: 6 gm. per day

• Duration: 3 days (As per *Aatur Agni*)

## 2) Aabhyantar Snehpan:

Pure Goghrita (Ghee):-

• Dose: 30 ml starting dose, in VardhmanaKrama (As per Aatur-Koshtha and Agni).

• Duration: 7 days (Depending upon the Samyak-SnigdhataLakshana)

• Anupan: UshnaJal

3) Abhyanga and Swedana: After obtaining SamyakSnigdhaLakshanas, Abhyanga with Nirgundi-Taila was done followed by SarvangaSwedana (BashpaSweda) in VishramKal (For 1 day) and on the day of Vaman Karma, prior to Vamana procedure.

As per the observations during the *Vamana* process**7** Vegas were obtained. *PravraShuddhi* was found and the *SamsarjanaKrama* of 7 days was decided according to the *Pravara* 

Shudhhi. The sequence of Peya, Vilepi, AkritaMudgaYusha, KritaMudgaYusha. Peya etc. was served for 2 Aahar Kala.

### ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Assessment was done on the basis of the criterias like *Paka*, *Srava*, *Kandu*, *Vedana*, *Daha*, *Vaivarnyata* and also symptoms of Acne like-Comedone, Papules, Pustules, Nodules,.

### **DISCUSSION**

- Vamanais said as the best treatment for the Kapha dosha elimination. In YauvanPidika, the mainly vitiated dosha isKapha. Other dosha which are involved in this disease are Vata andRakta. Rakta is Pittavargiyadravya and Vamana Purifies the Pitta also at some extent and thus it purifies the Rakta.
- In YauvanPidika, Srotorodha is seen in Swedavahasrotasa, Vamana drug with its Ushna, Tikshana, and Sookshma, Vyavyi, &Vikasi properties enters the large & small Srotas of the body and clears the Srotavarodha, which helps in breaking the chain of Samprapti.
- Dosha should be eliminated from the nearest path. YauvanPidika is Urdhvajatrugatavyadhi and Vamana expels the dosha from the Mukhamarga. Therefore Vamana karma will give better results than any other Shodhanakarma.

- In YauvanPidika, Rasa, Rakta, Mamsa and Medadhatus are vitiated, especially Meda. <sup>4-11</sup>Vamana karma possesses the property of purifying vitiated dhatu and increases the Dhatvagni, which corrects the disturbed dhatupakavyapar.
- Acharyas have described this disease as YauvanPidika, which shows the age of occurrence of the disease. AcharyaCharakahas described the age of 16-30 as VivardhamanaDhatukala, which is the starting period of functional state of ShukraDhatu. Modern medical science considered hormonal imbalance, specifically of androgens as one of the important causative factors, which in turn stimulates the sebaceous glands to produced excess sebum. This may be the cause that maximum patients were found in the age group of 16-20 years because hormones and Shukradhatu are more active during this period.

- Proper *Akanthapana* is an essential measure, which has its definite impact over the duration of *Vamana* and amount of the medicine to be ingested.
- On repeated recommendations by different *Acharyas* and considering the pathology of disease *Vamana Karma* was selected in the management of *Yauvan-Pidika* and marked improvement was obtained.

#### **CONCLUSION**

- In this case *KaphaDushti* was predominant in comparison to other *Doshas*.
- Hence Vaman Karma was preferred and Marked Improvement was obtained.

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
